### Primary Purpose of Position

Reporting to the Foreman PRA, the Field Operator will be responsible for safely monitoring and maintaining the area field facilities and wells on an ongoing basis.

### Responsibilities

- Control process start-up, shut down and troubleshooting
- Adjust valves, pumps, controls and process equipment
- Perform testing as required
- Identify equipment failures and take corrective action to restore operations
- Record required data from meter and instrumentation
- Input production information into field data capture system
- Monitor equipment and identify maintenance requirements
- Ensure compliance with Sinopec Canada's safety procedures and act accordingly
- Contribute to maximizing production potential and reliability of production levels
- Maintain complete and accurate logs for the use of company vehicles
- Provide recommendations for process and performance improvement
- Other responsibilities as requested

- Safety mindset with the ability to recognize and voice concerns over unsafe practices
- Ability to problem solve and effectively identify issues to develop and implement solutions for resolution
- Keen attention to detail and strong organizational skills
